Each unique table is impeccably hand-constructed in-house by partners Chanin Cook and Jonathan Edie with Claro Walnut slabs on top and German Fumed Oak as the base. We are head-over-heels for the way the organically shaped top provides a stunning contrast to the geometric base, and the way the tenons unite the rich tones of wood which balance one another beautifully. Chajo has long been known for its inspired designs in wood, metal and stone. We love that all of their designs are functional, contemporary and ... lovely.
